Although we are proud of our industrial heritage in the Tees Valley, we don't celebrate it very well. A great example are the ironstone mines on the Eston Hills. Their importance, and substantive remains above ground, would attract a visitor centre and tempting cafe if it was located in Surrey. Try your luck up there today and you'd be hard pressed to find much left. The railway legacy is better represented at least. A brick train sculpture, some models, artwork and even a working 'Flyer' can be seen around Darlington and Stockton. We even have a museum in Darlington called 'Head of Steam' housing that very first train 'Locomotion'. But there are definitely plans in place for the 200th anniversary of that first journey. A committee of enthusiastic individuals, councils and local organisations are already generating ideas about how we can make this a special event. The task today is based on that and could even feed into it. I can pass on ideas.
